

# Bible References

Many different Bible translations were considered for inclusion in this book. Unfortunately, most of the translations, including the NIV, NKJV, NASV, RSV, NRSV, NAB, and several others, are copyrighted and require royalty payments to reference their verses in mass (like in this book; we have approximately 700 verses within our footnotes in this book). For us to blanket the world with our book, and to keep our eBook free and our paperback cost as low as possible, we could not incur the cost of these royalty payments. Many of these translations are very good - but they become too expensive when trying to blanket the world with hundreds of thousands and possibly millions of book. Therefore, we had to make the difficult decision to use a royalty-free version of the Bible in our footnote references. The translation that we chose is a free and updated version of the American Standard Version (1901) called the World English Bible. The ASV was, and is, considered to be a very reliable and honest translation of the Bible. New American Standard Bible (NASB) verses are also referenced in this book and the NASB has a liberal use clause which allows us to reference up to 500 verses without written permission and without needing to pay royalty payments. If you have any questions about any of the verses/references that we used within this book we recommend that you cross-reference it with the Bible translation that you prefer to see what your translation says. We are not for, or against, any translation, we simply want to get this message out to the entire world - without paying royalties - so everyone in the world can learn about Jesus and understand God's will for their life.

- <sup>14</sup> Isaiah 53:5 But he was pierced for our transgressions. He was crushed for our iniquities. The punishment that brought our peace was on him; and by his wounds we are healed.
- <sup>15</sup> Psalms 16:10 For you will not leave my soul in Sheol, neither will you allow your holy one to see corruption.
- <sup>16</sup> Psalms 68:18 You have ascended on high. You have led away captives. You have received gifts among men, yes, among the rebellious also, that Yah God might dwell there.

- <sup>20</sup> Colossians 1:15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. <sup>16</sup>For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. <sup>17</sup>He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.
- <sup>21</sup> Hebrews 1:3 His Son is the radiance of his glory, the very image of his substance, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself made purification for our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.
- <sup>22</sup> Hebrews 2:17 Therefore he was obligated in all things to be made like his brothers, that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make atonement for the sins of the people. 18 For in that he himself has suffered being tempted, he is able to help those who are tempted.

- <sup>25</sup> Mark 14:58 "We heard him say, 'I will destroy this temple that is made with hands, and in three days I will build another made without hands.'"
- <sup>26</sup> Matthew 20:28 even as the Son of Man came not to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."
- <sup>27</sup> Mark 14:29 But Peter said to him, "Although all will be offended, yet I will not." 30 Jesus said to him, "Most certainly I tell you, that you today, even this night, before the rooster crows twice, you will deny me three times." 31 But he spoke all the more, "If I must die with you, I will not deny you." They all said the same thing.
- <sup>28</sup> John 13:18 I don't speak concerning all of you. I know whom I have chosen. But that the Scripture may be fulfilled, 'He who eats bread with me has lifted up his heel against me.' 19 From now on, I tell you before it happens, that when it happens, you may believe that I am he.
- <sup>29</sup> Mark 14:17 When it was evening he came with the twelve. 18 As they sat and were eating, Jesus said, "Most certainly I tell you, one of you will betray me--he who eats with me."
- <sup>30</sup> Luke 18:32 For he will be delivered up to the Gentiles, will be mocked, treated shamefully, and spit on. 33 They will scourge and kill him. On the third day, he will rise again.

- <sup>32</sup> John 16:16 A little while, and you will not see me. Again a little while, and you will see me." 17 Some of his disciples therefore said to one another, "What is this that he says to us, 'A little while, and you won't see me, and again a little while, and you will see me;' and, 'Because I go to the Father?'" 18 They said therefore, "What is this that he says, 'A little while?' - <sup>38</sup> Matthew 17:22 While they were staying in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is about to be delivered up into the hands of men, <sup>23</sup> and they will kill him, and the third day he will be raised up." They were exceedingly sorry.
- <sup>39</sup> Matthew 16:21 From that time, Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders, chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and the third day be raised up.
- <sup>40</sup> Isaiah 42:6 I am the LORD, I have called You in righteousness, I will also hold You by the hand and watch over You, and I will appoint You as a covenant to the people, as a light to the nations, <sup>7</sup> to open blind eyes, to bring out prisoners from the dungeon and those who dwell in darkness from the prison.

- <sup>44</sup> 1 John 1:5 This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.

- <sup>46</sup> John 10:10 The thief only comes to steal, kill, and destroy. I came that they may have life, and may have it abundantly.
- <sup>47</sup> Matthew 5:16 Even so, let your light shine before men; that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.
- <sup>48</sup> 1 John 4:10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son as the atoning sacrifice.

- <sup>50</sup> Ephesians 1:11 in whom also we were assigned an inheritance, having been foreordained according to the purpose of him who works all things after the counsel of his will;
- <sup>51</sup> John 10:10 The thief only comes to steal, kill, and destroy. I came that they may have life, and may have it abundantly.
- <sup>52</sup> Mark 4:15 The ones by the road are the ones where the word is sown; and when they have heard, immediately Satan comes, and takes away the word which has been sown in them.

- <sup>55</sup> John 18:37 Pilate therefore said to him, "Are you a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this reason I have been born, and for this reason I have come into the world, that I should testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice."

- <sup>88</sup> I Corinthians 1:18 For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are dying, but to us who are saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, I will bring the discernment of the discerning to nothing."20 Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the lawyer of this world? Hasn't God made foolish the wisdom of this world? 21 For seeing that in the wisdom of God, the world through its wisdom didn't know God, it was God's good pleasure through the foolishness of the preaching to save those who believe.
- <sup>89</sup> 1 Corinthians 2:9 But as it is written, "Things which an eye didn't see, and an ear didn't hear, which didn't enter into the heart of man, these God has prepared for those who love him." 10 But to us, God revealed them through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.
- <sup>90</sup> James 1:5 But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach; and it will be given to him. 6 But let him ask in faith, without any doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, driven by the wind and tossed.
- <sup>91</sup> Isaiah 5:20 Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; who put darkness for light, and light for darkness; who put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! 21 Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight.

- <sup>98</sup> Matthew 25:46 These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.
- <sup>99</sup> Revelation 14:11 The smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever.
- <sup>100</sup> 2 Thessalonians 1:9 who will pay the penalty: eternal destruction from the face of the Lord and from the glory of his might,
